



# The Wolfreton Rushanje Community Partnership

The Wolfreton Rushanje Community Partnership is a partnership between Wolfreton School in Willerby, East Yorkshire and Rushanje Girls Secondary School in South Eastern Uganda and both their local and business communities.

It has developed over the last 10 years into a close relationship with mutual benefits. Through reciprocal visits the two schools have learned about each other's culture, made friends and forged curriculum links.

Rushanje Girls Secondary School is situated in a remote valley in South Eastern Uganda about thirty miles from Mbarara town. There are about 400 students currently on roll, most of whom are boarders and some 30 Staff. Unlike Wolfreton the school draws its students from a wide rural area.

Since 2007 both schools have been actively involved in a Curriculum Project sponsored by The Department for International development and administered by The British Council.
