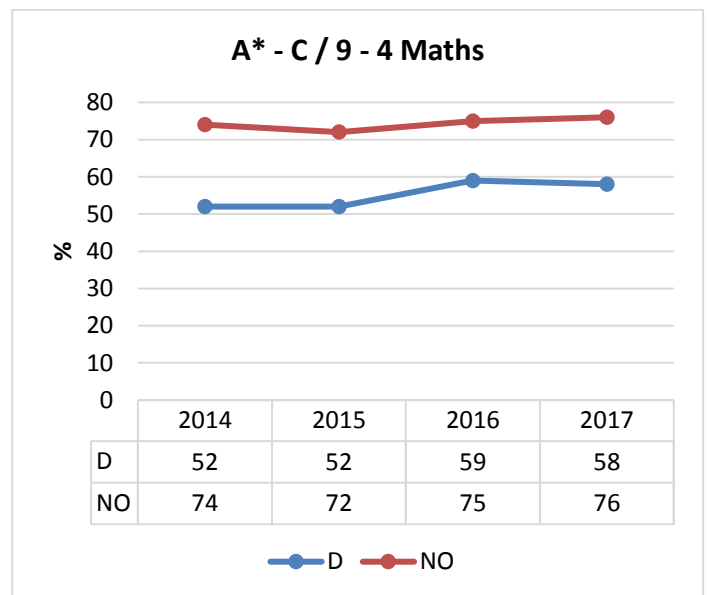
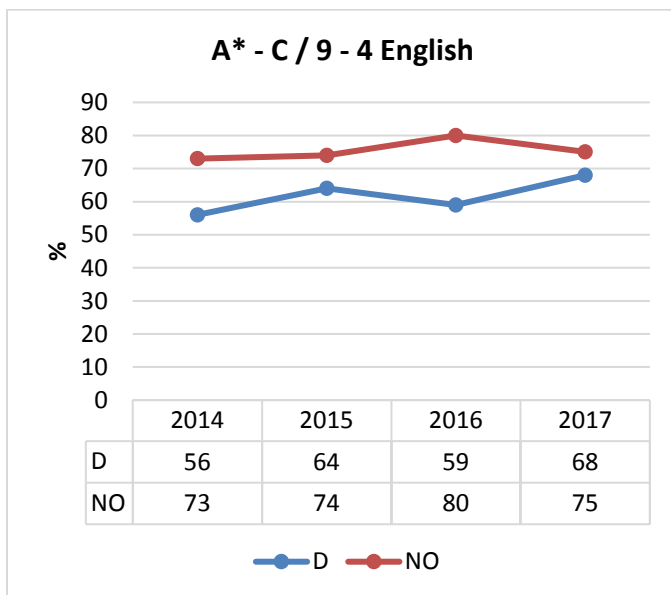
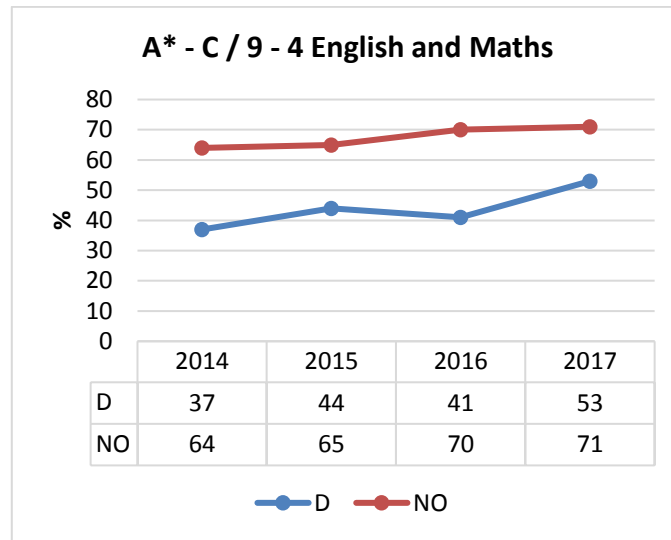


Pupil Premium Impact 2014 - 2017

Strategies in English and maths have reduced the Basics gap between disadvantaged students and the National Other from -27 in 2014 to -18 in 2017. There has been a significant reduction in English Language, from -17 to -7 over the same period. In maths, the gap reduced from -22 in 2014 to -16 to 2016. The gap in 2017 was recorded as -17 following the introduction of the new style GCSE.



Destinations

As a result of CEIAG and PP PM support, Destination data confirms that all students in the disadvantaged group progressed on to Sixth Form, an FE College, an apprenticeship or Adult Education. No students are recorded as NEET.
